Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order with the following present:

Consent Agenda is approved.

Resolution# 7-2018 Adopting the Clinton County Multi-Jurisdictional Local Hazard
Mitigation Plan. John Mirosh, seconded by Ken Tongue, made a motion for the first read.
Tracy Pincus, seconded by Ken Tongue, made a motion for the second read. Mayor
polled the with the following results: Clyde May Yes, Doug Goode Yes, Cam Collins
Absent, Ken Tongue Yes, John Mirosh Yes, and Tracy Pincus Yes. **Therefore**
Resolution# 7-2018 is passed.

Discussion Items:

Two (2) Sealed Bids were opened for the Lot on Redbird. Reserve was not disclosed til
tonight and was set at \$3,500.00.

First Bid was submitted 07/11/2018 10:00 am by Frank Lewis for \$3,010.00.

Second Bid was submitted 07/03/18 10:55 am by John and Lisa Russell for \$1,500.00.

Greg will contact Mr. Lewis since his bid is highest and see if he will meet reserve.

Then Greg will contact Mr. and Mrs. Russell to do the same if Mr. Lewis does not meet
reserve. If neither party meets reserve it will be put back up for bids.

Greg Harris informs the council that the Perkins Park Lift Station has been approved. Approval was a record time now the Bidding and all specs will be getting put together.

Greg Harris moves on to Section 505 (Dangerous Buildings) he states Doug Goode came in regarding some properties that needed repair. Greg then spoke with Jayson Watkins (City Pros. Attorney) regarding the matter and discussed how to handle it. Greg supplied the council with a summary and pictures of some properties he had observed. The Mayor suggests council some time and study the situation including finding other properties and will discuss at next meeting.

Greg had a meeting regarding the SRO (School Resource Officer) program with Sandy Stegall. With the school going to a Four (4) day week it changes the way the officer is paid. Simplest is to split Half n Half between school and city. The school is also appointing a Safety Committee Meeting. All council think program is a good idea and are for it.

Greg informs council that Clyde May (alderman) came to him with photos of damage that happened to Perry Park over the 4th of July. Council discusses ways of approaching vandalism in all parks.
