Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order with the following present: Larry Schussler, Douglas Goode, Cam Collins, Eric Niemann, Sandra Utz, and Tracey Pincus. Also present were Larry Jackson, Joe Trotter, Brenda Lehmer, Joyce Ketchum, Gene Grafton, Steve Tinnen, Mary Jane Goode, Jason Utz, Travis Shaver, Rod McQuerry and Cindy Fulk.

Cam Collins led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Schauer read the Black History Month Proclamation.

**Public Comments:**

Gene Grafton read aloud a letter he had written to Mayor Schauer.

Travis Shaver asked the reasoning behind not being able to park his work truck in his driveway. Mayor Schauer said to meet with Larry Jackson and maybe work out a place to park in town.

Larry Jackson thanks the council and audience for all the support shown from community.

**Discussion Items:**

Joe informed the council that in February that the Advisory Committee will meeting to discuss possible improvements. MO DNR issued proposed operating permit for WWTP.

Dr. Hobbs has received the contract regarding the 9<sup>th</sup> street project and will get back with Joe. Limiting Garage Sales was discussed and a ordinance will presented at next council meeting. Guidelines for council was tabled. Mickey Streeter will be honored at next council meeting and city is looking to hire part time help.

Larry Schussler spoke about the water supply program that was started in 2013 but had not been followed thru with. Mayor Schauer will address in Utility Committee meeting. Larry continued on and asked for I&I meeting. He then informed council that the City was in violation of Section 115.130 of City ordinance. Schussler continued on regarding various ditches and culverts that needed to be cleaned out. Schussler made a motion to the council that the Street and Alley committee and the Mayor obey city ordinances. No second was offered, Schussler then stated he was calling the Attorney General's office and the Governor. Doug Goode and Mayor Schauer stated that Public Works had been making repairs along the way.

Cam Collins, seconded by Doug Goode, made a motion to adjourn to Executive Session. Motion carried 6 ayes 0 nays.
