January 10, 2019**

Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the following present: Clyde May, Douglas Goode, Cam Collins, John Mirosh, Tracy Pincus also present were Greg Harris, Chief Couzens, Steve Tinnen, Tom Morsbach, Scott Alexander and Larry Schussler.

Dave Schauer led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS:

Scott Alexander would like to purchase City Lot (Defreece donated to City) and put a warehouse on it for internet-based E-bay business. Would put a Wood fence up for storing larger items.

Tom Morsbach (A Bum's Charity) wants to put on a Dinner/Comedy show March 9th at Tinnen Town Hall. His charity stays local FFA, Daughters of the American Revolution and funded two kids to go to Washington D.C.. It will be a (21 and over) show and wants to have beer and wine by the drink \$20.00 tickets for presale. Hoping to come back for February Meeting.
