AT 7PM.**

Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order with the following present: Larry Schussler, Douglas Goode, Eric Niemann, and Tracey Pincus. Sandra Utz and Cam Collins were absent. Also present were Joe Alonso (filling in for Larry Jackson), Joe Trotter, Gene Grafton, Steve Tinnen and John Bless.

Mayor Schauer led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comments:

Doug Goode, seconded by Larry Schussler, made a motion to accept the Consent Agenda. Motion carried 4 ayes 0 nays 2 Absent

Bill No. 1331 an ordinance to regulate smoking in places of public accommodation in the City of Plattsburg, Missouri. Eric Niemann, seconded by Doug Goode, made a motion for the first read. Larry Schussler, seconded by Tracy Pincus, made a motion for the second read. Mayor polled the with the following results: Tracy Pincus Yes, Sandra Utz Absent, Eric Niemann Yes, Cam Collins Absent, Doug Goode Yes and Larry Schussler Yes. **Therefore Bill No.1331 became Ordinance No. 2295.**



No Executive Session


