Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order with the following present: Larry Schussler, Douglas Goode, Cam Collins, Ken Tongue, Greg Harris and Tracey Pincus. Also present were Joe Trotter, Gene Grafton, Mary Jane Goode, Steve Tinnen and T. Prausa.

Cam Collins led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Schauer states Cindy Spellman has resigned from the Park Board and Andy McNeely will be taking her place unless there are objections. No Objections.

Doug Goode, seconded by Ken Tongue, made a motion for the second read. Mayor polled the with the following results: Larry Schussler Yes, Doug Goode Yes, Cam Collins Yes, Ken Tongue Yes, Greg Harris Yes and Tracy Pincus Yes. **Therefore Bill No.1343 became Ordinance No. 2307.**

**Discussion Items:**

A draft handout of Eclipse Safety was presented to all. Joe had visited with Superintendent and they will not have school day of Eclipse. Tracy Pincus suggested a Cooling station in the Community Courtyard Building. Interim Chief Tatum discussed safety concerns regarding Perkins Park, Staffing, Command Posts and numerous other issues.

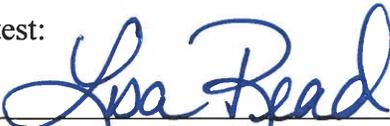
Ken Tongue, seconded by Doug Goode. Made a motion to adjourn to Executive Session, Motion carried 6 ayes 0 nays.
