**MINUTES FROM THE PLATTSBURG CITY COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT
PLATTSBURG CITY HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS ON April 20, 2017
AT 7PM.**

Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order with the following present: Larry Schussler, Douglas Goode, Cam Collins, Eric Niemann, Sandra Utz, and Tracey Pincus. Also present were Joe Trotter, Gene Grafton, Ken Tongue, Mary Jane Goode, Brenda Lehmer, Joyce Ketchum, Tony Holland, Eileen Holland, Sean Gross, Cathy Jackson, Sara Niemann, Tom Lacy, Greg Harris, Bradley Lawrence, Steve Tinnen, Grace Spezia and Zach White.

Cam Collins led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Schauer reads a Proclamation for years of serving as aldermen on the city council Eric Niemann and Sandra Utz.

Public Comments:

Zachary White conservation agent spoke to council regarding coyote issue.

Johnathan Harrup with Nick's Health Center approached the council regarding connecting to the city's sewer system. They are needing a permanent solution to their wastewater issues. Mr. Harrup asked if he could put a proposal together for the utility board committee to review within a couple of months. Tom Lacy with RSTC said would start two months after approved and complete within the year roughly. Cam Collins stated prior owners had a study done. No Objections regarding them to put together a proposal.

Joe Trotter (on Karen Porter's behalf) owns a parcel in Lake Concord and ties in with city's right of way. Council has no objection for her to approach council about gifting to city.

Brenda Lehmer addressed the council with numerous locations of code violations in the city. A list was made of locations and passed on to the Police Department.

Mayor polled the with the following results: Tracy Pincus Yes, Sandra Utz Yes, Eric Niemann Yes, Cam Collins Yes, Doug Goode Yes and Larry Schussler Yes. **Therefore Bill No.1340 became Ordinance No. 2305.**

Joe gave a update on storm sirens and options of getting more sirens in different locations.


Council spoke on opinion of City Admin and Chief of Police living in town. Mayor polled council that both positions live in town. 6 ayes 0 nays.
