OCTOBER 15, 2018**

Dave Schauer, Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the following present: Clyde May, Douglas Goode, Cam Collins, John Mirosh, Ken Tongue and Tracy Pincus, also present were Greg Harris, Chief Dave Couzens and officer Jensen.

Dave Schauer led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda is approved.

Bill No. 1386: An ordinance amending Section 205.090 “animals-keeping” prohibited and replacing section 205.100 “keeping of registered Pitbull’s of the municipal code of the City of Plattsburg. John Mirosh made a motion for the first read. Seconded by Clyde May. Clyde May made a motion for the second read, seconded by Ken Tongue. Mayor Schauer polled with the following results: Clyde May YES, Doug Goode YES, Cam Collins YES, Ken Tongue YES, John Mirosh YES, Tracy Pincus YES. **Therefore Bill No. 1386 became Ordinance No 2350.**

Bill No. 1387: An ordinance approving the January 1, 2018 through June 30, 2018 Annual Financial Statement. Tracy Pincus made a motion for the first read, seconded by Clyde May. Clyde May made a motion for the second read, seconded by John Mirosh. Doug Mayor polled with the following results: Clyde May YES, Doug Goode YES, Cam Collins YES, John Mirosh YES, Ken Tongue YES, Tracy Pincus YES. **Therefore Bill No. 1387 became Ordinance No. 2351.**

Discussion Items:

Mayor mentioned street work to be done possibly Friday or Monday with weather permitting. If weather does not permit it could be next spring before street work can be done.

Mayor discussed that letters and notices have been sent to property owners of abandoned building and condemned like properties. Time to start addressing homes and properties that are run down, messy yards, etc. All council members are to keep an eye out for these types of properties.

Nothing but good comments on all Fall Festival activities.


There being no further business to discuss, Cam Collins seconded by Ken Tongue, made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. 6 Ayes.
